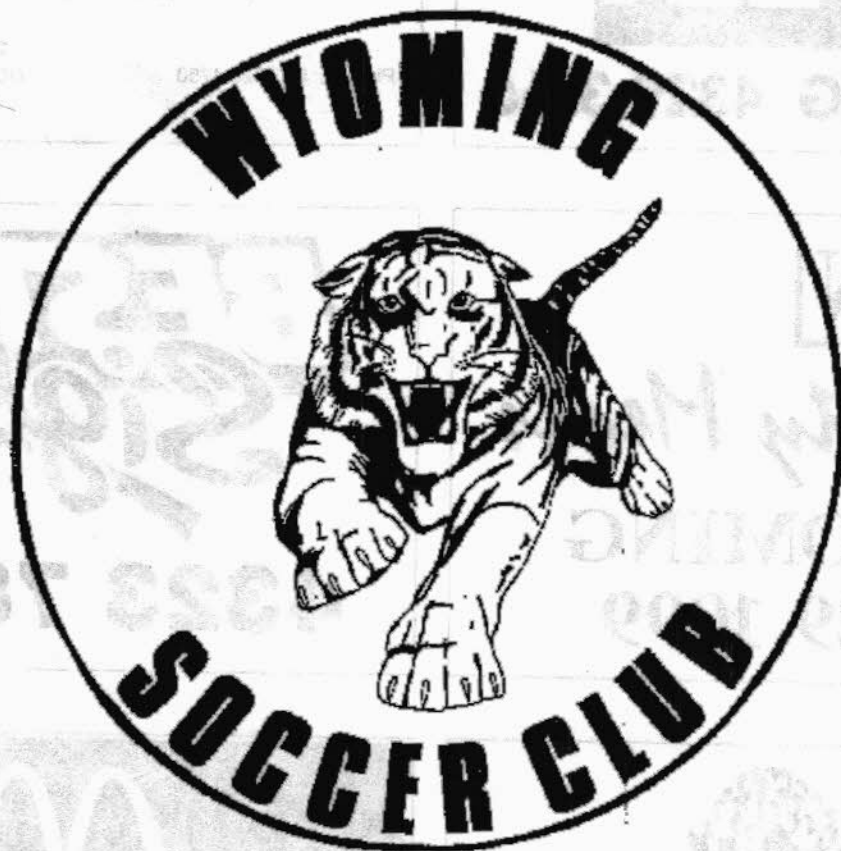

Aug 22: Wyoming 2 Terrigal (2) 0

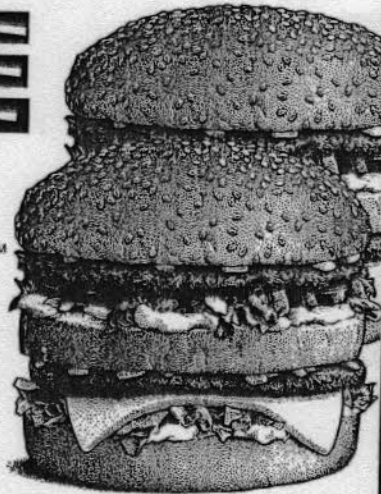
