



1998 UNDER 7 GALA DAY PROGRAMME

WELCOME

Welcome to players, officials, parents and spectators to the 1998 Wyoming Soccer Club Under 7 Gala Day. 23 teams from the Central Coast Soccer Association and one from the Kuringai Association have nominated. Four fields will be in operation and the Gala Day rules appear on the following page.

The canteen will be in operation serving hot food (pies, hot dogs, bacon & egg sandwiches, sausage rolls, hot chips) and drinks (tea, coffee, soft drinks and juices). Barbecued steak and sausage sandwiches can be purchased by buying tickets at the canteen. A cake and lolly stall has been set up under the large tent. The club will be holding two raffles during the day. Tickets are \$1 or three for \$2.

We trust all players, parents, supporters will join the Wyoming Soccer Club in sharing an enjoyable day. Good luck to all teams.

SIDELINE CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

- Encourage children to participate, if they are interested. However if the child is not willing do not force him or her.
- Focus upon the child's efforts and performance rather than the overall outcome of the event. This assists the child in setting realistic goals related to his/her ability by reducing the emphasis on winning.
- Teach children that an honest effort is as important as victory, so that the result of each game is accepted without undue disappointment.
- Encourage children to always participate according to the rules.
- Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- Remember children are involved in organised sports for their enjoyment, not yours.
- Remember that children learn best from example. Applaud good play by all teams.
- If you disagree with an official, raise the issue through the appropriate channels rather than questioning the official's judgement and honesty in public. Remember, most officials give their time and effort for your child's involvement.
- Recognise the value and importance of volunteer coaches. They give of their time and resources to provide recreational activities for the children and deserve your support.

RULES

1. The referee's decision will be final on all points of law.
2. All teams are to report to the official table and be ready to play each game at the designated starting time.
3. All games will be started on time and controlled by the Gala Day officials. There will be no time off for injuries. Coaches and managers may assist injured players on the field while the game is in progress, provided that the referee considers that this does not interfere with play.
4. Teams listed first on the draw will kick-off, with the team listed second having the choice of ends. This must be decided prior to each game and the referee notified prior to kick-off.
5. Games will be of two seven (7) minute halves with no half-time break. At the completion of each half teams will change ends and be ready for kick-off at the official re-start signal.
6. The competition will be based on a round-robin format with points allocated: 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw and 0 points for a loss. A forfeit counts as a 2-nil win to the non-forfeiting team.
7. Protests, if any shall be lodged with the Gala Day officials, together with a \$15 fee, before the start of the team's next match. The Gala Day officials shall decide on the protest. If it is upheld then the fee will be returned. The Gala Day officials' decision shall be final.
8. At the end of the rounds the winning teams in each group will progress to the semi-finals. If teams are equal on points the team with the best goal difference shall be the winner. If goal differences are equal the team with the most goals will be the winner. In disputed cases the decision will be made by the Gala Day officials.
9. The major semi-final will be played between the first and third teams according to the point score, the minor semi-final between the second and fourth teams with the two winners competing in the final.
10. Semi-finals and the final shall be played for ten minutes each way with a five minute half-time break.
11. In the event of a draw in the semi-final the team with the highest score on the day will progress to the final.
12. In the event of a draw in the final, one five-minute period of extra time shall be played. Teams must change ends with the toss of a coin to decide the kick-off. At the end of extra time if the scores remain equal the team with the most points (taking into account goals for and against in the semis) shall be declared the winner. The final decision shall be made by the Gala Day officials.
