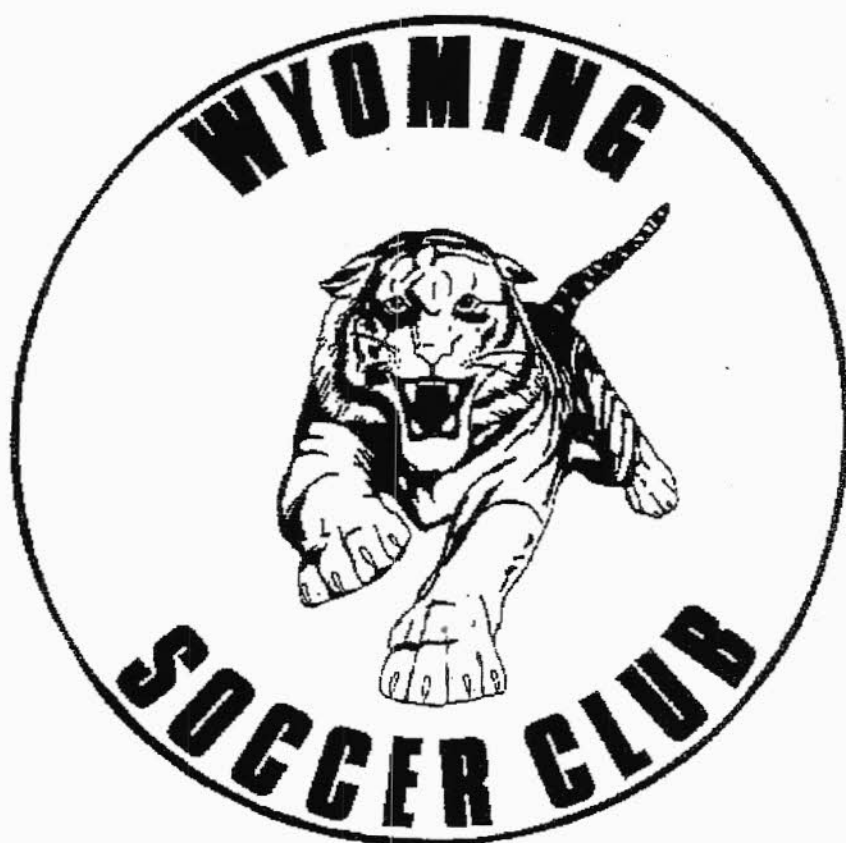

CANTEEN REPORT

This is our first report for the 2000 season and we would like to welcome everyone back and extend a special welcome to the new parents.

For your convenience we have included a price list for gear currently available. Gear can be purchased at the canteen on Saturday throughout the season.

The position of Canteen manager, as with all the positions on the committee are filled by volunteers. Unlike other positions the canteen needs your help to be able to stay open all day. As we are parents like yourselves and have children whose competition games we want to attend, teams are rostered to help between 9-00am and 3-30pm. You will only be required on roster for a period of approximately two hours throughout the entire season. Your manager will tell you when you are rostered. When working in the canteen you will be supervised and only have to do counter serving.

Without your help the canteen will be forced to close for periods of time and sales lost. The Canteen profits are important to the Club and are used to the benefit of the players.

Unfortunately during the 1999 season we repeatedly notified managers that their teams were required for canteen duty and we were constantly disappointed by the lack of response by teams who did not show up. This left the canteen short staffed and we were forced to then call on a small number of willing teams and individuals who gave more than their fair share of assistance.

If we do not obtain the help required to staff the canteen we may be forced to look more closely at teams constantly ignoring requests for help. If there are no parents in your team available for that particular time slot it's your responsibility to swap with another team. So please come in and see us as your help will be greatly appreciated by us, the players and the Club.

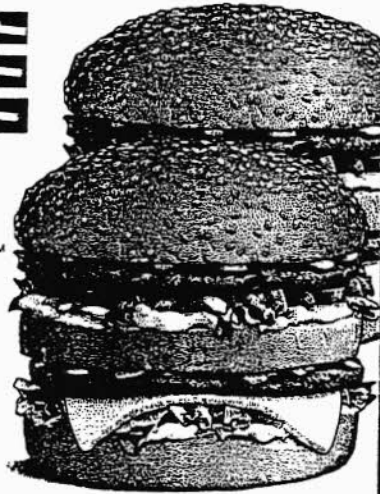
