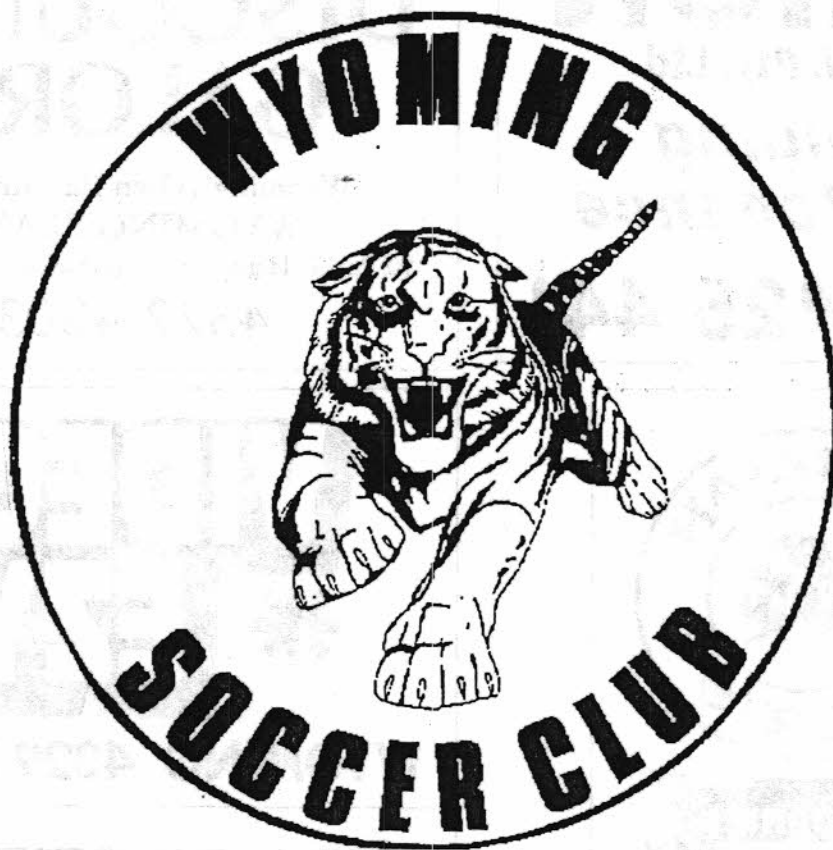

WYOMING SOCCER GIRLS BAND TOGETHER

Wyoming Soccer Club has 44 girls playing in three womens soccer teams, and dozens of other girls playing in junior mixed teams

The all-girl teams are an undefeated Under 14 side, and both 3rd and 2nd Division Senior sides.

Sheridyn Fisher and Megan Whittington from the Under 14's, and Sarah Allard and Hannah Bellato from the 3rd Division seniors, will accompany the Central Coast Womens Soccer Association Development teams to play in the prestigious Kanga Cup in Canberra during the first week in July.

The two teams will spend a full week of soccer, playing against high-level interstate and overseas teams.

With full support from Wyoming Soccer Club, the girls' teams have banded together to help the girls meet the costs incurred to get them to this great tournament.

Wyoming's Ladies Rep, Peter Morrison said " In past years Wyoming has had girls represent Australia, New South Wales, and local representative sides, and we have always tried to help."

The girls have already raised \$500 with raffle tickets and a barbecue at Alan Davidson Oval. They also had a car-wash at Ampol Stop-Shop at Lisarow on Saturday 18th June, which raised over \$200.

A BBQ, cake stall and raffles at Fagan Park, Point Clare, on Sunday 25th June will close the

fund-raising. The big raffle will be drawn on that day, and the girls will head off into snowy Canberra during the following week.

Wyoming girls are hoping to raise enough money to cover all costs for their for teammates, and wish them the best of luck.

At the club level, our Under 14's are still undefeated and are in third spot, Senior Thirds have had a few wins, and Senior 2nds have moved into second place following two wins over the long weekend.

LEVEL 1 COACHING COURSE

The Club will be organising a Level 1 Coaching Course in the near future. Level 1 is the minimum qualification which should be held by all current coaches.

The Level 1 is a "hands on" course covering a range of subjects including organising and running a training session, ball and skills training and sports injuries and how to avoid them.

The course is highly recommended for any current coach not already at this level.

The course is run either over a weekend or for four nights and the maximum number which can be accepted is 24. It costs \$50.00 but in recognition of the value of the course the Club is prepared to subsidise \$30.00 of the cost leaving each participant to pay just \$20.00.

Subject to final numbers it is expected that the course will be run at Alan Davidson Oval.
