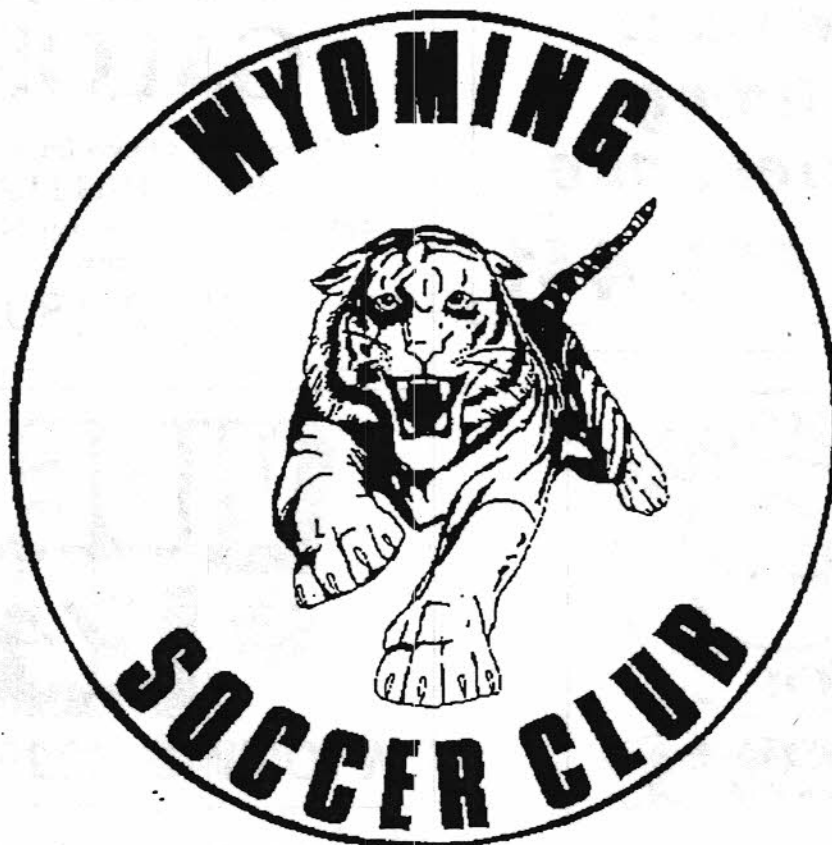

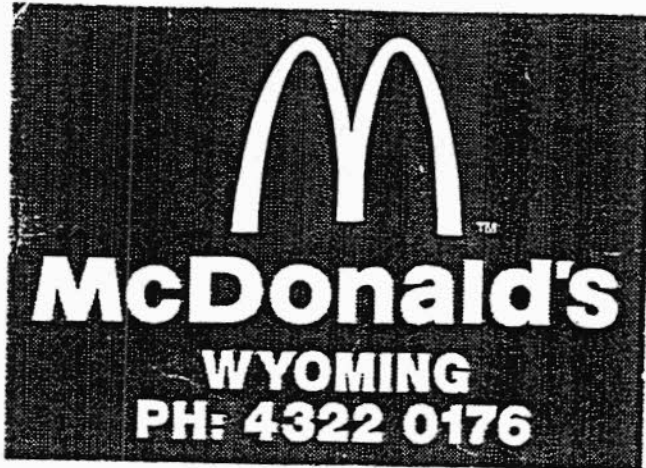

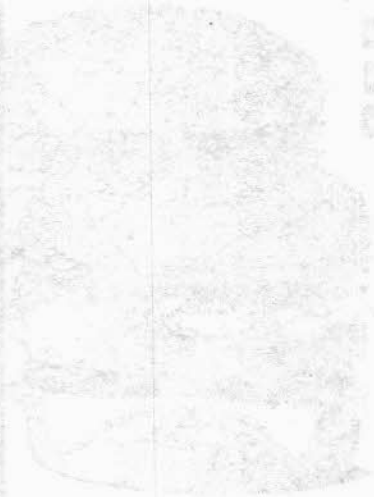
### Jul 11: The Entrance 2 Wyoming 1
