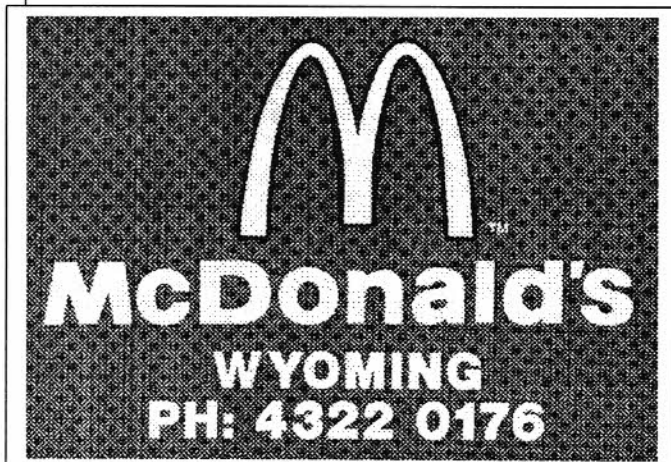
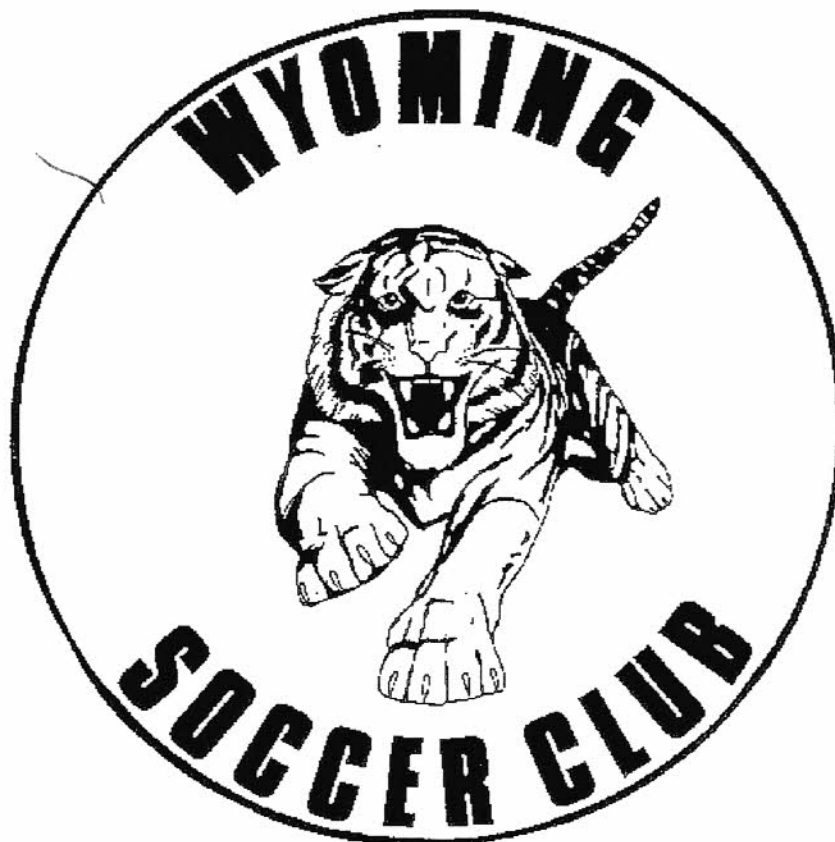

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

I would like to take this opportunity to welcome past and new players to the club.
