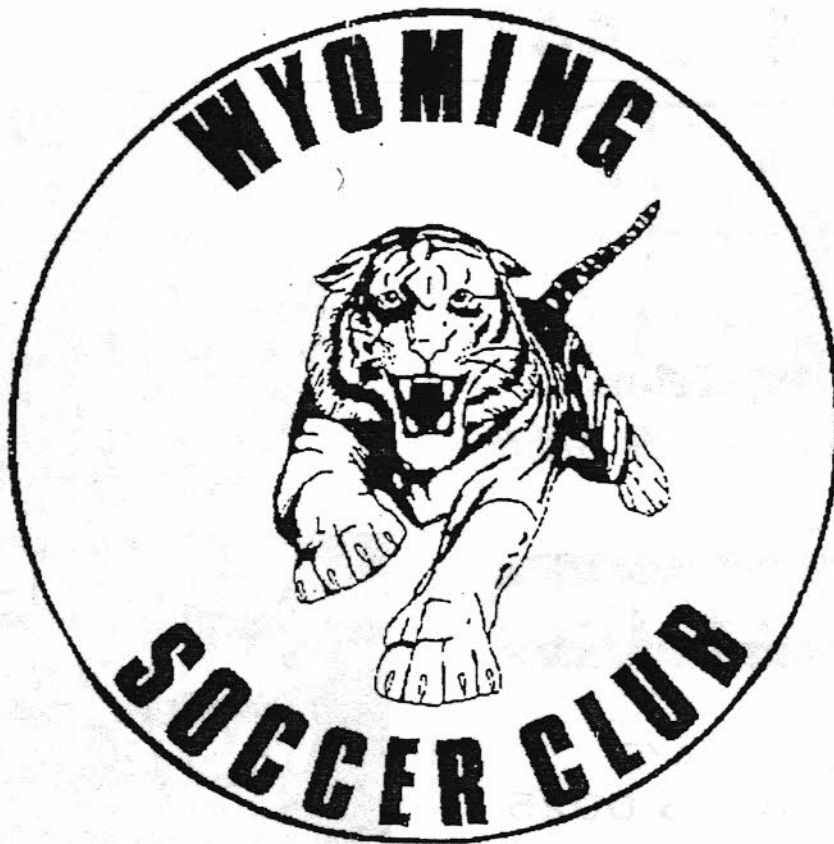

LADIES REP'S REPORT

I believe that Womens Soccer is the only growth area in Wyoming Soccer Club this year, and from what I hear, there is a big jump all round the Central Coast. There are 9 more teams in girls/Womens than in 2000.

This year we have 5 teams, two up from last year.

We have an enthusiastic Under 12s side coached by Cheronne Nicholas, who also plays 1st grade Womens.

Our Under 14s are undefeated, and are coached by George Savidis.

The Under 16s have only played two matches, for two good wins and are already in the middle of the points table. Their coach is Scott Howison who is fairly busy. He coaches U16, and U18 boys, U16 girls, and plays 1st grade mens in his "spare" time.

We have two Senior Womens teams, with 3rd Division coached by Bruce Miller and 1st Division coached by Colin Muldoon. Third Div are currently undefeated, and 1st Division, who won last years 2nd Division comp, are settling in to 1st Division.

There are also numbers of girl players in 5-16 mixed teams, many of whom will be moving to all-girl teams next year.

Soccer has become the most popular sport for females in the USA, and may be likewise in Australia before long.

Over the years there have been Wyoming girls who have gone on to represent Central Coast, NSW and even Australia.

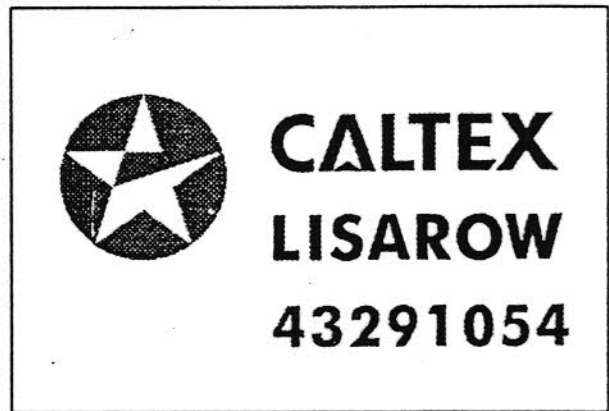
