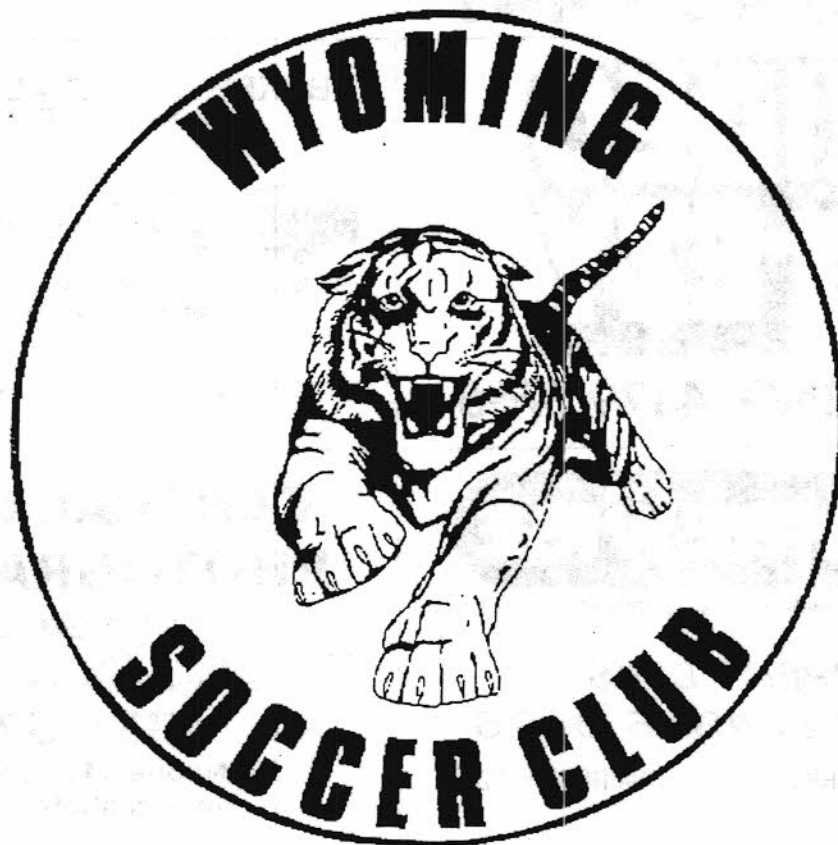

SECRETARY'S REPORT

2001 will go down as one of the most successful for the Club in recent years.

Compared to last year when five teams qualified for the finals, this year we have produced 19 finalists with six teams taking out the League Championship. After the finals, six teams progressed to the Grand Final and three became Grand Final winners. My congratulations go to all teams for their efforts this year.

Additionally, the Club has been instrumental in Gosford City Council allocating funding of \$200,000 for the upgrading of Alan Davidson Oval. Whilst actual works are yet to be determined this funding will see a significant improvement in the quality of the playing fields. I would like to especially mention the efforts of Councillor Daniel Cook in raising awareness in Council of the need for these works and in co-ordinating the process of using the available funds.

The Committee has once again shown their preparedness to give the time and effort needed to ensure the smooth operation of the Club. Apart from the week to week football commitments through the season the Committee has successfully organised the:

- Pre-season grading and trial days
- Annual Under 7 Gala Day
- Canteen (the Club's major fund raiser)
- Non-Comp, Junior and Senior Presentation Days
- Coaches and managers get togethers
- Summer Coaching Clinic

Without naming any one individual, I would like to thank each and every Committee member for their efforts this year which have been the backbone on which the Club has enjoyed its success.

The other unsung heroes are, of course, the coaches and managers, who give their time and effort to take the raw untrained talent of Wyoming youth and mould it into the lean mean winning teams that we have seen this year.

I believe the success of the teams can be attributed to three things. The significant effort put into correctly grading both the players and the teams, a commitment to improve the qualification of current coaches and attract quality coaches to the Club and a small shift in the emphasis of the Club to provide more encouragement for teams to perform on the field.

I trust these factors will prove to be a winning combination for the Club in the years to come.

Sep 2: East Gosford 3 Wyoming 2

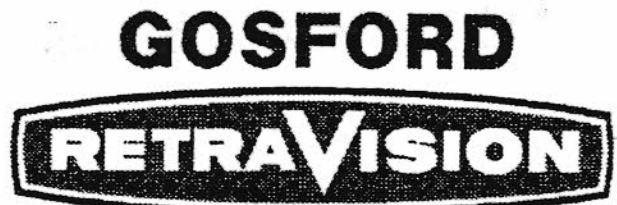
