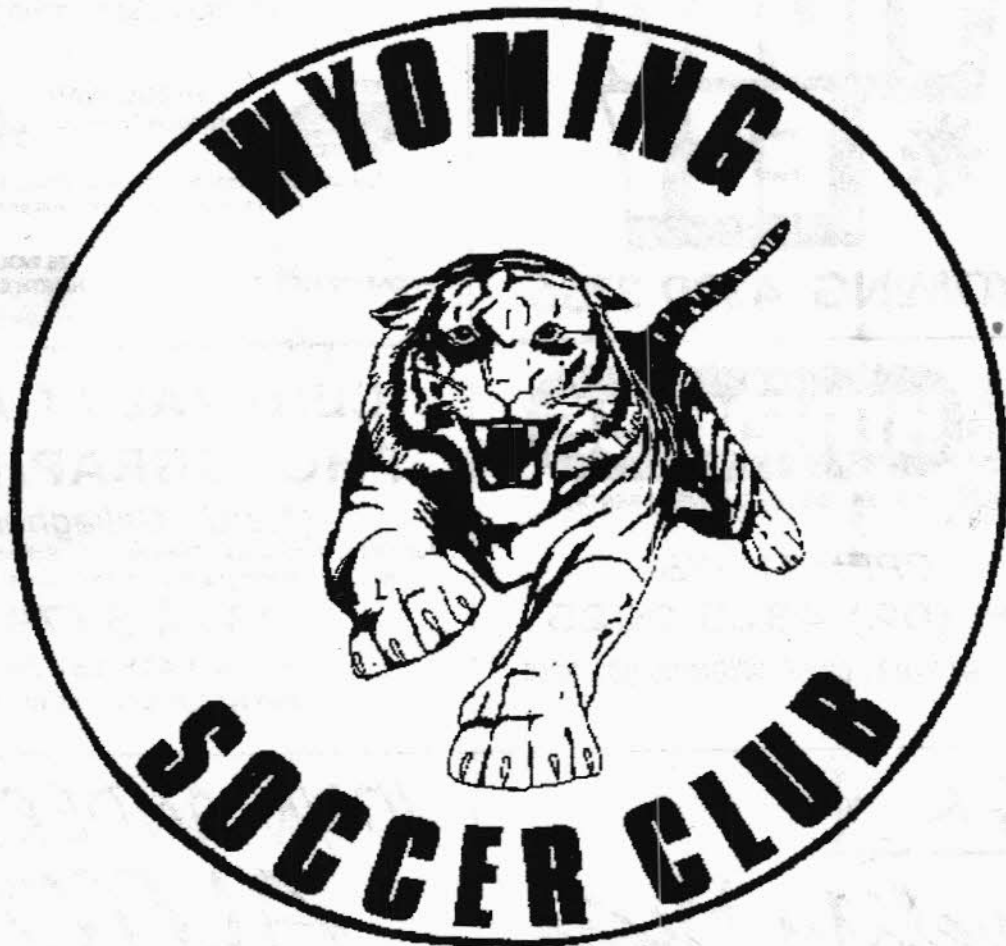

## PRESIDENT'S REPORT

I would like to take this opportunity to welcome past and new players to the Club for the 2002 season.

I am confident the new Committee will work well together with some very experienced members continuing on and a couple of new members in Laurie Morgan, (Gear Steward) and Steve Grahame ( Fixtures) who have joined us. However, both have had previous experience with other clubs.

The committee has appointed Craig Herring as first grade coach following a successful 2001 season where first grade were finalists and reserve grade were league champions. Ken Butt has been appointed reserve grade coach and we are confident that they will get good results this year. Our senior ladies and our junior teams also did extremely well in 2001, so the Committee are confident that we should have a great 2002 season

Unfortunately, Registration costs to the Club have risen sharply, mainly in insurance costs and Soccer Aust increasing it's levy from \$2.20 per player to \$6.50 for juniors and \$12.00 for seniors. The average cost of registering a Junior player has risen by \$7.66 and a Senior player by \$15.70.

In order to try and keep Soccer in the Wyoming area more affordable, the Club has decided to absorb some of these costs and has only increased registrations by \$5.00.

The Club will also continue the Family discount scheme. Based on last year's registrations this will result in a loss of revenue of around \$2400.

On the brighter side the Club will again give every player that registers the opportunity to win a \$500.00 voucher at Gosford Marketown Retravisation store and In the interest of hygiene we will supply water bottles to all junior players.

We also hope that all members will support the above action and strongly support our Canteen this year to help make up some of the difference

Enjoy your season, support our teams and sponsors and if you have any problems don't be afraid to seek help from your Committee members.
