As we move towards the end of the of the 2003 Season, the Club is performing well on and off the field with around 14 teams in contention for the finals. As I write this report, 4 teams have finished League Champions, our First Grade had an excellent year back in the Premier League 1 competition finishing just 2 points out of the semis. Our under 18C team made the Final and our U18A team will be playing in the Grand Final at Northpower Stadium on Sunday 24 August.

The Club had a record 630 players register at the beginning of the season creating a lot of work for the Committee in placing players into teams, finding Coaches and Managers for around 53 teams and providing them playing and training kits. Around half of those teams being in the U5 -U9 Non Comp Group.

The Club ran 2 gala days for U6 and U7 in June, with a Wyoming team in the final series at both days, I would like to congratulate Gai Green and her sub-committee on the successful running of these gala days. Also we should thank our junior players who came forth to referee. They did an excellent job for the Club.

To the Committee I thank you for the many hours you have put into the running of the Club this year. We had good numbers at registrations, grading days, trials, gala days etc; on the official table and assisting Elizabeth in the Canteen. Through your efforts you have made the Club one of the strongest on the Coast on the field and administratively off the field.

As you would appreciate supplying over 50 sets of playing strip to teams each year is a major expense to the Club. This would not be possible without the generous support of our sponsors. The Club wishes to thank you for your sponsorship and hope that you continue to support the Club next year.

To all Coaches, Managers, Players, Parents and Committee I thank you for your time and effort. in making 2003 a successful Season. The Committee hopes you enjoyed your year at Wyoming and we look forward to seeing you all in 2004.
