The Club had a most successful season in 2003 with 14 teams in the final series. 6 teams being League Champions and the Club won 7 Premierships, 4 in the juniors and 3 in the seniors.

Our senior teams performed well with our First Grade after promotion to Premier League 1 only missing the Semis by 2 points a great effort. Our 18A, 18C, AA2 were Premiers, AA5 runners up and our AA1 Women's team made the Final.

In the junior competition 6 teams finished as League Champions and 4 teams were Premiers, The 14A girls were runners-up.

The Club won the Central Coast Soccer Association's Jack Atkings Trophy for the most successful Junior Club a great effort.
