Welcome to all past and new players to the Club for the 2004 season.

Last season was one of our most successful for many years with our Premier League 1<sup>st</sup> Grade just missing a semi spot after being promoted. Both our U18 teams won their Premierships, which gives us plenty to build on to bolster our Premier League Squad.

The Club had 6 junior competition League Champions and 4 Premiers spread over the U11 to U15 age groups and won the Jack Atkins trophy for the most successful junior Club on the Central Coast.

The Club has appointed John Mc Lafferty as First Grade Coach and Ken Butt as Reserve Grade Coach for 2004. With these two coaches we are confident that the Club can again be successful in the top League this year.

Off the field the Club has lost a couple of very experienced Committee members in Bruce Barret and Gai Green who have made a large contribution to the running of the club over the years and will be sorely missed. **The Committee only has 8 members covering 19 positions. So anybody in the Club that would be willing to assist would be most welcome.** Running a Club with around 630 players and about 45 teams is a big job for so few. **With around 2000 members including parents and players surely there must be people out there that have some time to assist.**

Half the current Committee has been around for over 15 years and we need new blood to come in to train to keep this great Club running.

Unfortunately, the Club has had to lift registration fees this year due to added costs of insurance and various levies. At the last Association meeting it was indicated that this may be around \$10 a player, however at going to print these fees were not finalised.

To minimum the cost for families, the Committee will continue the family discount scheme to try and keep soccer more affordable.

**What we would like are some interested new faces to join our Committee, learn the ropes, and help out during the season, with a view to taking on a more responsible position in 2005.**

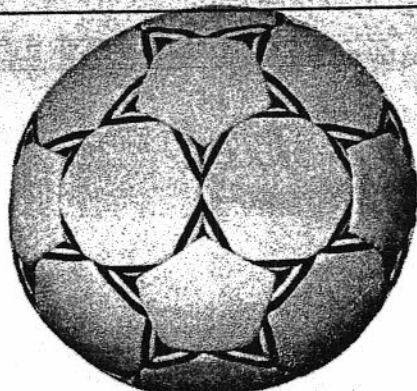
Also available in 2005, for computer-literates are the positions of Registrar and Fixtures Officer.

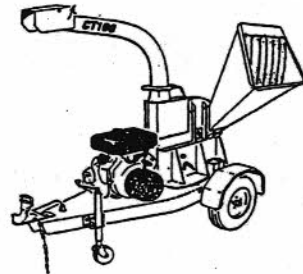
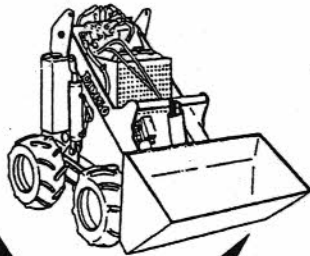
