PRESIDENT'S REPORT

The Club had a most successful season in 2004, at the time of writing this report we had 14 teams in the final series, 5 teams being League Champions.

First Grade Premiers - 2004

Our Senior teams performed well, with our First Grade finishing in second spot in Premier League 1 and our Reserve Grade just missed a Semi spot by 1 point, although their goal average was better than teams above. **Our Premier League Squad and Coaches have elevated the Club in 3 seasons from 5th in PL 2 in 2001, (15th spot of 20 Clubs) to 2nd spot in PL 1 in 2004, A great effort.** Our 18A are League Champions for the second year in a row and our 18 B, AA4 are also Semi-finalists.

In the Junior Competition 4 teams finished as League Champions.

A record 638 players register at the beginning of the season creating a lot of work for the Committee in placing players into teams, finding Coaches and Managers for around 50 teams and providing them playing and training kits.

To the Committee I thank you for the many hours you have put into the running of the Club this year. We had good numbers at registrations, grading days, trials, gala days etc; on the official table and assisting Elizabeth in the Canteen. Through your efforts you have made the Club one of the strongest on the Coast both on and off the field.

I would like to thank our SPONSORS for their generous support. Due to their financial assistance the Club completed a 3 year Program and ALL our Junior Teams from U5 to U16 are PLAYING IN THE YELLOW MADRID STRIP, which I believe is another first for the Club. The Club wishes to again thank you for your sponsorship and hope that you continue to support the Club next year.

To all Coaches, Managers, Players, Parents and Committee I thank you for your time and effort, making 2004 another successful Season. The Committee hopes you enjoyed your year at Wyoming and we look forward to seeing you all in 2005.
