## PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Welcome to all past and new players to the club for the 2007 season.

Last season was another successful year for the Club.

A total of 10 out of 15 junior teams made the semi finals with 3 of the teams becoming League Champions. For the first time in the clubs history, we had 8 Senior teams out of 11 in the Grand Final. Two of these senior teams were League Champions while four of the eight teams won their Grand Final. For the first time in about 18 years, the club became Premier League 1 Senior Club Champions.

The club has appointed Greg Preston as First Grade coach this year. Greg coached the Reserve Grade team last year to a premiership and we are very confident that he will guide the club to another successful year in the Premier League in 2007.

I encourage everyone to support our successful Premier League teams on a Sunday afternoon, especially when they are playing at Alan Davidson Oval.

Off the field, the club has a number of vacant positions on the committee. It is becoming increasingly difficult to run a club this size with volunteers, so any help would be greatly appreciated. A list of the vacant positions are listed on the website. If you would like further detail on the vacancies, don't hesitate to contact a committee person.

Level 4 and the possibility of level 5 water restrictions on the Central Coast will mean this year is going to be very difficult for all sporting organisations on the Coast. Gosford Council has restricted the usage of grounds for training purposes, so I ask everyone to be understanding with us when we allocate training times and venues. We will of course endeavour to accommodate a teams preferred time if possible, however at times this may not be possible.

Unfortunately, the club has had to lift registration fees this year. This has been brought about by increased charges placed on the clubs by the Central Coast Football Association. We have limited the increase to a minimum and you will find our fees are very comparable to other clubs. Additionally, we have kept the family discount scheme in place again this year to try and keep soccer more affordable to our members.

Enjoy your season at Wyoming, support our teams and sponsors and if you encounter any problems, don't be afraid to seek assistance from your Committee members.

## FIXTURES REPORT

Firstly I would like to welcome all existing families back to Wyoming and welcome all new families to our Club for season 2007.

I will ask that all teams be patient with me this season, as this is my first as fixtures. You normally see me in the canteen but this season I am trying the other side of the bars.

Once your children have been placed in teams they will be appointed a coach and manager who will be your first port of call should you have any queries with regard to games etc. We also ask that you keep a keen eye on our Club web page for current information, if you do not have the internet please check with your manager.

All clubs have been advised by CCF that due to ground conditions and pending Level 5 water restrictions grounds may be closed at short notice and if possible games will be moved to other grounds not affected (we have been told that ours is one of the better grounds..... AT THE MOMENT).

CCF have also advised the first game of the season is 13<sup>th</sup> April, 2007 (middle of Easter school holidays) and that games will be played on the June long weekend Saturday, Sunday and Monday (if Council permit, they may wish to rest grounds) and all weekends of school holidays. If there are washouts these will have to be played midweek and/or Sundays to catch up.

If for any reason a team cannot field the minimum number of players CCF will fine the club the relevant forfeit fee (competition teams), so please if possible make yourself available for the whole season. If you have planned for holidays where possible try to be back for the weekend.

The aim is to have as many kids on the field for the whole season.

For season 2007 CCF are introducing teams for Girls U10, Women O35 and G45 for men. If interested in any of these grades please let us know and we will see what we can do.

We trust you have an enjoyable season beginning with gradings on 17<sup>th</sup> February.

## **WYOMING SOCCER CLUB**

### **TEAM SELECTION POLICY**

#### **ALL PLAYERS**

**All players must register in their correct age group. No player shall be permitted to play in a higher age group without the approval of the Football Committee.**

#### **NON-COMP**

U5 – U8: The CCSA regulations request that these teams not be graded.

U5 – U7: These teams will attend one activity day so as to be placed in teams on the basis of being with friends or for transport logistics etc.

U9: The CCSA requires this age group to be graded on ability and should attend two grading days. These teams will be graded by a grading committee comprising the non-comp rep and at least 2 other members. They will select 12 provisional players per team depending on numbers. The players, parents and coach will be advised that they may be changed to another team during or after trial games have been completed. The selection of the final team will be made by the grading committee and the coach, after the final trial game.

#### **JUNIOR COMP**

U10 – U17: The CCSA requires these age groups to be graded on ability and should attend two grading days. These teams will be graded by a grading committee comprising the junior comp rep and at least 2 other members. They will select 14 provisional players per team depending on numbers. The players, parents and coach will be advised that they may be changed to another team during or after trial games have been completed. The selection of the final team will be made by the grading committee and the coach, after the final trial game.

#### **U18 and AA MEN/WOMEN**

These teams will be graded by a grading committee comprising the coach of the team and at least 2 other members and will be graded at Senior Training and during trial games. The AA grading committee will have to liaise with the Premier League coaching staff on final selection.

#### **PREMIER LEAGUE MEN/WOMEN**

The Premier League will be graded at Senior Training and during trial games by the coaching staff and players not selected will be asked to join other players to form an AA1 team.

#### **DISPUTES**

Any disputes arising out of grading will be dealt with by the appropriate rep, grading committee and Football Committee chairperson, if required.

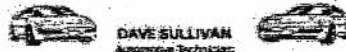
