

2015 Wyoming Football Club Historical Summary



This biggest talking point for this season was the shock departure of 10 first grade players from last years 2014 squad. Several players retired (Daniel Surrige and Marc Falzon). The others moved to other clubs, with a majority crossing the creek to Gosford. It did not leave new coach, Greg Ko-cass (pictured right), with a great number of experienced players to start the season. It was a hard season for the team, but to their credit and the coach, produced a standard, that was not expected, and fought their way to a respectable place and securing a place in the top league for 2016. Full credit should be given to those who participated in a somewhat difficult season.

This season was mediocre for the Club overall with only six teams making the semis. The best performance was, without doubt, the **Girls 16A** team following their successful season last year. The team entered the NSW Champion of Champions, but were eliminated in the quarter finals by Kiama 0/0 (2/4) in a penalty shootout.

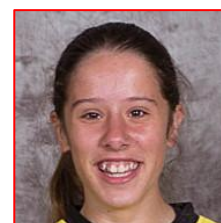

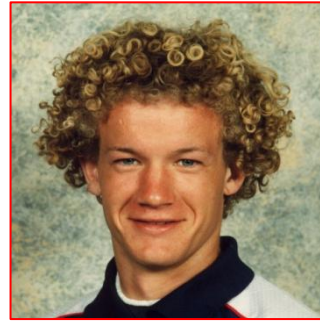
