## Historical Summary

The Men's 1<sup>st</sup> Grade team and the Women's 1<sup>st</sup> team again played this season in the second tier level. The season finished the year with the Men's First Grade regaining a berth in the Central Coast Premier League for the 2019 season. Having spent season 2017 and 2018 in the 1<sup>st</sup> Division competition after being relegated in 2016. It was a nail biting finish to the First Grade competition, and it was not until the last game was played that the Club knew their destiny. The Club quickly gained the services of Ian McAndrew (ex-Wyoming Junior and ex-Gosford in recent time) as the head coach. It is an important decision in the right direction for sustainability in the 2019 season. A hearty thank you must go to outgoing First Grade Coach Scott Howison for his efforts in driving the 1<sup>st</sup> team into second position of the competition and his assistance to the Reserve Grade coach Dave Boyd, which won the Premiership after finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> and defeating the two teams above them in the final series to win the Grand Final. Congratulations to Patrick Mills for his Player of the Year award for both the Club and the CCF.

**WOMEN'S TOP TEAM:** The Club's top women's team (WAA1), coached by Vanessa Quick, made a valiant run to the Semis finishing in second spot, but failed to make the Grand Final losing 0/3 to Toukley in the Semi and losing 0/1 to a "golden goal" in extra time to Terrigal's 2<sup>nd</sup> team in the Preliminary Final. Although disappointed, the future looks good for a possible return to the Division 1 competition for 2019. Mention must be made to the excellent way Vanessa Quick handled her first coaching job.

### OVERVIEW:

**NEW PRESIDENT** One of the landmark appointments made for the 2018 season was the election of Scott Snodgrass to the position of President of the Club. Scott is the youngest Wyoming junior Wyoming player (U7 1985) to be elected to the position. Although it has taken near to fifty (50) years to evolve, it's a good sign for the Club's future.

**PRESIDENT'S TROPHY.** One of the best Club performances for 2018 was the promotion to the Premier League of the First Grade and Reserve Grade teams coached by Scott Howison and Dave Boyd respectively. The entire squad was rightly awarded with the Trophy.

**UNDER 11** Another success story was the Non Comp U11A and U11C teams (coached by Kevin Flanagan and Justin Aysford respectively). Both won their way to the Final Game in their respective CCF U11 Round Robin Tournament at Plum Park held during the season. The 11A lost 2/4 by East Gosford and the 11C were declared Joint Winners with SEU after a storm terminated the finish of Final Play-offs. It is the second year in a row that the Club has had good results in this U11 Tournament.

**COMPETITION TEAMS** With regard to all twenty (20) competition teams, the Club only won two trophies, namely Reserve Grade Premiership and the Under 12D Premiership (Coached by Simon Ainsley). Both teams finished third and won the next three games to win the Premiership. Overall, thirteen (13) teams made the Semi Finals, eight reached the Preliminary Final, five played in the Grand Final and two won it.

**OAM** One history making occasion was the OAM awarded to Kevin Best in the Australia Day Celebrations on 26th January for 60 year service to football 1958-2017 for playing, coaching and administration. Kevin has spent: 30 years as a player (Hurlstone Park 17, Canterbury Assn 8, Wyoming 13, Central Coast Assn. 1), 43 years as a coach (Hurlstone Park 5, Wyoming 28, Central Coast 8, Kincumber 2), and 48 years as an administrator (Hurlstone Park 5, Canterbury Assn 2, Wyoming 23, Central Coast Assn. 24).

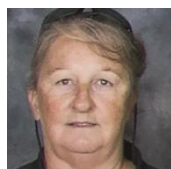

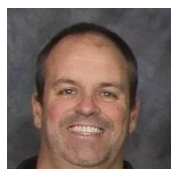

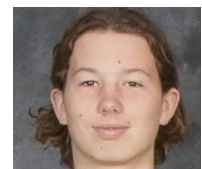
