Historical Summary



The promotion, this year, to the Premier League Men's 1st Grade team saw major changes in the player structure for 3 teams (First, Reserve and Under 21 grade teams) with new coach Ian McAndrew (pictured left) recruiting positively in the off season. Only four players from 2018 First team remained in 1st Grade. Some of those new players were Wyoming juniors returning after stints elsewhere. The season overall was a very positive start in the top tier with a Semi Final position secured.

Our Senior Men's grades (BPL / O35s / MAA) also picked up the **MEN'S SENIOR CLUB** of the year award at the 2019 CCF Chairman's dinner in recognition of their combined success.

The Club's highest graded women's team was an All Aged 4 team. They did battle to gain a Semi Final position and won their way to the Grand Final only, sadly, to be beaten 0-4.

OVERVIEW:

PRESIDENT'S TROPHY. The best team performance for 2019 was the Over 35B team who won the League Championship and the Premiership (Grand Final winners).

UNDER 11 TOURNAMENT Another success story was the Non Comp U11AS and U11CS teams (coached by Ryan Marshall and Tim Dawson respectively). Both won their way to the Grand Final in their respective CCF U11 Round Robin Tournament at Plum Park held during the season. The 11AS were beaten by Terrigal 1/3 and the 11CS defeated Sth Ett United 3/1. It is the third year in a row that the Club has had good results in this U11 Tournament.

COMPETITION TEAMS With regard to all twenty two (22) competition teams (from U12 to Seniors), the Club won 6 trophies, namely 4 League Champions (35B, 35DS-2, AA4, 14B) and 2 Premierships (35B, 35DS-1). Overall, 11 teams made the Semi Finals, four reached the Preliminary Final, seven played in the Grand Final and two won it. A special mention should be made towards the high standard of the players in the Club playing in the U18 and U21 age groups. The two U18 teams reached the Grand Final and the U21 made the Semis.
