



2026 Season Guide

Welcome to the Wyoming FC 2026 Season Guide. This guide has been prepared to bring together all key information for the upcoming season, including registrations, important dates, fees, team formation, training arrangements, and member responsibilities. It is designed to help players, parents, coaches, and volunteers clearly understand club expectations and season requirements, while supporting a smooth, safe, and well-organized 2026 football season for the entire Wyoming FC community.

Season & Competition Overview

What is Mini Roos

MiniRoos in New South Wales (NSW) is designed to provide children aged 4 to 11 with a fun and inclusive introduction to football, following specific rules and formats to enhance their learning experience.

MiniRoos is a smaller version of football aimed at young players, focusing on skill development, teamwork, and enjoyment. The program is structured to cater to various age groups, typically using formats such as 4v4, 7v7, and 9v9, which help children transition to the full 11v11 game as they grow older. Season Timing

The 2026 season starts 10 April.

MiniRoos (U5-U11) finish in August (no finals).

Competition teams (U12+) finish in September.

Trial games are usually held in March before the season begins.

Where Games Are Played

Games are played across 23 Central Coast Football clubs.

Travel ranges from Gwandalan (North) to Umina (South) and Mangrove Mountain (West).

MiniRoos usually play in local hubs to reduce travel.

Game Days & Times

Saturdays: MiniRoos, Junior Mixed (U12-U14), Men's 15s, 16s, 35s, 45s.

Sundays: Girls-only teams (U12-All Age) and Men's All Age.

Younger teams generally play earlier, but field shortages mean some later games too.

Team & Field Sizes

U5-U7: 4 players + reserves, small field (no goalkeeper)

U8-U9: 7 players + reserves, medium field

U10-U11: 9 players + reserves, $\frac{3}{4}$ field

U12+: 11 players + reserves, full field

Game Duration

U5-U7: 2 × 15 min

U8-U9: 2 × 20 min

U10-U12: 2 × 25 min

U13-U14: 2 × 30 min

U15-U16: 2 × 35 min

All Age: 2 × 40 min

Premier League: 2 × 45 min

Competition vs Non-Competition

U5-U11: Non-competitive, focused on fun, learning, and friendships.

U12+: Competitive football on full-sized fields.

Grading

U5–U7: No grading, grouping only.

U8: Soft grading to balance teams.

U9+: Players grouped by ability; grading becomes more structured through to U12.

Team Continuity

Teams can't always stay together due to changing team sizes (e.g., 6-a-side → 9-a-side at U8).

Friendships are considered, but balanced teams are also important.

Coaches & Managers

Usually a parent, relative or carer. We provide plenty of support for anyone taking on a coach or manager role. Helpful resources are available on both the Wyoming FC [website](#) and the Central Coast Football (CCF) [website](#), and there are also coaching courses and workshops offered throughout the season.

Please first register (free) ASAP then email your age rep with an expression of interest.

Missing Games

Occasional absences are fine.

Frequent absences affect the team, especially in higher grades (A grade, Premier League).

Girls-Only Teams

Available for U5–U11 (Saturdays).

U12–Women's All Age play on Sundays.

Training Times

Set by the Football Committee based on availability.

Training is held on Tuesdays, Wednesdays or Thursdays (club ground access days).

Mixed Teams

Mixed boys-and-girls teams run from MiniRoos to U16, playing on Saturdays.

Competition Draw

Competition draw may change and be updated throughout the season from what is initially released. Wet weather matches may be rescheduled to blackout weekends during school holidays and/or the end of season. Midweek games may also be scheduled to avoid any games being cancelled.

Payment Options

- Play Football requires Full payment by Credit/Debit Card at the time of registration.

Please Note: WFC is no longer able to support payment plans, however WFC will continue to support families in genuine hardship. Requests based on hardship must be made in writing to treasurer@wyomingfc.com.au (Ineligible for any other discounts).

No discounts will be applied to any fee variations, including those resulting from delayed payments due to financial hardship. All discounts remain at the discretion of Wyoming FC.

Registration Fees and Cost Breakdown

There are a number of costs associated with delivering football at club level, including:

- Playing shirts
- Footballs
- Referee fees
- Ground hire and maintenance
- Line marking
- Nets, goal posts, corner flags, and training equipment
- Trophies and awards
- Insurance coverage for registered players and officials
- Ongoing maintenance of our clubhouse

In addition, Central Coast Football, our governing body, provides and manages key competition services, including:

- Competition administration
- Weekly match scheduling
- Judiciary and disciplinary processes
- Referee development
- Trophies and awards
- Maintenance of Plum Park

Central Coast Football has also introduced a Facility Levy of \$10.00 per player, which will be reinvested over time to improve facilities for all affiliated clubs.

NO PAY, NO PLAY

A player **will not** be activated in the CCF MyComp App, **will not** be allocated to a team, and **will not** be permitted to participate in any training or matches **until full registration payment has been received and confirmed in PlayFootball.**

Any player who has OUTSTANDING REGISTRATIONS OR MATCH FEES FROM 2025 or prior will be asked to clear all outstanding debt prior to being accepted for the 2026 season. All payments for this will be accepted on a credit card/bank transfer only basis.

WFC reserves the right to decline any registration or discount as per its constitution.

Refunds

Players who cancel their registration after the CCF season commencement may only receive the WFC portion of the registration fee as a refund at the discretion of the club, less any costs, including any items received.

Team Formation & Grading

PLEASE NOTE: If you have a request regarding which team, you or your child wishes to play for, this must be submitted in writing to your Age Representative before team selections begin ([see Key contacts](#)). While no guarantees can be made, the club will make every effort to accommodate player or parent preferences where possible and in line with club policy.

Age Group Requirements

- Age groups are determined by the age a player turns within the calendar year.
- All players must register in their correct age group.
- Proof of age (ID) is required for all new players or upon request.

Special Requests

Any special requests will be reviewed by the Football Committee; however, approval cannot be guaranteed and will depend on team balance, player numbers, and club policy.

U5-U7 Teams will be selected/grouped from short games played. Please note, these teams are not graded. If you would like your child to be in a specific team, please email our Football Committee Age Rep below. Dates TBA

U8-U18 Teams will be graded & selected from these grading days. Refer to event schedule for grading / grouping days. Our football committee and grading panel will conduct skills sessions and small side games to determine which side your child will be placed in based on their ability. – Dates TBA

Men's and Women's All Age/O35-45s - Teams are by nomination. Assistance can be sought from our Senior Representatives if looking for a team ([see Key contacts](#)). Team grading will be decided by the Football Committee based on the players within the squad and last year's results.

ALL PLAYERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR FOOTBALL BOOTS & SHIN PADS TO GRADING / GROUPING DAYS.

Men Premier League (MPL) - Training and team selection is already underway. Contact our Head Coach Scott Snodgrass – scottsnodgrass1978@gmail.com for details.

Once teams have been finalised, registered coaches and managers will be assigned to their respective teams. Following these allocations, training days, times, and field assignments will be released.

Coaches and managers may choose to establish a team messaging group to assist with communication; however, it remains the responsibility of all participants and families to stay informed. Central Coast Football (CCF) is our governing association, and the [CCF MyComp App](#) is the primary communication tool throughout the season, providing access to fixtures, results, washout notifications, and other important updates. Members are also encouraged to regularly check and follow the Wyoming FC [website](#) and [Facebook](#) page for club-specific information and announcements.

Training Schedule

Training is held Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 4pm at Alan Davidson Oval.

Training times are set exclusively by the Football Committee.

Ages 5–7 will be allocated one of the three training days.

Older competition age groups may be allocated two of the three days.

All scheduling is based solely on field availability.

Coach availability may be considered, but only if space and scheduling allow.

All decisions made by the Football Committee are final.

No Wyoming FC–affiliated training is permitted outside your team’s scheduled times.

Players will not be covered by insurance if injured during unsanctioned sessions, and the club may face council fines for **unauthorized** field use.

Parent Responsibilities

Parents/guardians are required to supervise their children at training and assist the coach in managing behaviour to ensure the safety of all players and the proper use of club-supplied equipment.

Uniform & Equipment

- Football boots & shin pads – required for training and game day – available to purchase from sporting and shoe stores.
- Club shorts & socks – required for game day- available for purchase from the club on designated Information days and from the Club canteen on home game days.
- Training shirt – encouraged – worn for training and to and from games - - available for purchase from the club on designated Information days and from the Club canteen on home game days.
- Game-day shirts - required – Each team is issued a ‘kit’ with a game day ball and game day shirt – these are for game days only and remain the property of the club - any inappropriate use, or wear of game shirts outside of club games may incur a charge for replacement.
- Training equipment -some will be made available to each team **only during their allocated training session**. All equipment **must be used appropriately and packed up immediately after training** and returned to the gear shed so it is available for other teams.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES is any team permitted to remove club equipment from the field or take it off-site unless prior authorisation from the football committee.

Non-compliance may incur a charge for repair or replacement.

Referees

Matches for age groups U12 and above are officiated by CCF-appointed referees. For age groups U5 to U11, games are overseen by Wyoming FC cadet referees, who are typically young players with an interest in officiating. These cadet referees are still learning and developing their skills, and patience and encouragement are essential.

Central Coast Football enforces a strict zero-tolerance policy toward abuse of referees. Any abuse, particularly toward referees under the age of 18, will be treated very seriously and may result in severe penalties under CCF and Football NSW regulations.

Code of Behaviour – Mandatory Compliance

Any player, spectator, coach, parent, official, or any person present at a match or involved in any activity staged or sanctioned by CCF or its member clubs is required at all times to follow the [CCF Player and Spectator Code of Behaviour / Conduct](#).

Failure to comply may result in immediate removal from the venue and/or cancellation of registration.
